

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Entrants agree to abide by ruling and instructions issued by or on behalf of the Carnival committee

No floats to arrive at the assembly area with persons on the back of vehicle

Nothing may be thrown from vehicles

No alcohol is permitted before or during the procession

Marshals will direct the float and all other entries to the dispersal area where all the money collected in the carnival procession must be handed in to the officials

Bucket collection can only be in aid of BRCA in official Carnival buckets

Drivers towing a float should make sure that the vehicle they use is insured for this purpose and has relevant MOT and tax

The floats should be mechanically safe e.g. brakes, lights and safety wires fitted

Adult supervision must be provided where young children are participating

A nominated person must ensure that there is no jumping on and off floats whilst they are moving

Speed limit should be kept to walking pace and protection must be provided over wheels if participants are to be seated with their legs hanging over

No person to travel or walk on the draw bars of tow vehicles or stand on travel boards/ steps of the vehicle whilst the procession is moving

Please always remain vigilant during the procession and particularly in the assembly and dispersal areas. All persons on floats must alight in the dispersal area once the float has parked

No persons under any circumstances will be allowed to travel on floats after dispersal. At this stage normal traffic/ highway rules apply

All participants in the Carnival parade, whether walking or on a moving vehicle, **MUST** be insured including PLI of £5mil. Please check with your clubs or organisations that this is in place and a copy **MUST** be sent to organisers with parade entry form. Advice on insurance can be obtained from Mike Maskell of Robins Rowe Insurance, Aldwick, Tel. 01243 841710, or your usual insurance company
